WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS OF HAVING A NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN?

A Neighbourhood Plan gives the community more control over development, ensuring any new development meets local needs, protects valued green spaces and assets, as well as deciding where new buildings are to be built and even influencing their design.

In a nutshell, it means that the community has a shared say in the vision for their areas future development, rather than leaving decisions to external bodies. There are also financial benefits to having Neighbourhood Plan. Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) is a levy that Local Authorities can impose on new developments. A portion (15%) is then passed on to parish councils to fund community projects. If a Neighbourhood Plan is in place, the % given by the Local Authority to the Parish Council increases to 25%

WHAT'S THE LATEST?

Neighbourhood Plan Boundaries
